Mission Statement

History

In May of 2000, Christi and Mark Tripodi experienced the sudden loss of their three-year old son, Bobby. Along their grief journey, they recognized a tremendous need for a center that was totally dedicated to bereavement care. Responding to God's call, the Tripodi Family founded Cornerstone of Hope in 2003. Since opening, Cornerstone has served more than 30,000 individuals through a variety of professionally led programs.

Core Programs

Cornerstone of Hope offers the following critical services: Grief Counseling, Art Therapy, Support Groups, School Programs, Memorial Ceremonies, Youth Grief Camps, Education and Training, Resource Library, Crisis Intervention and Volunteer Opportunities.

Who We Serve

Cornerstone of Hope serves children, teens and adults who seek support after the death of a loved one. We also support professionals in the community through continuing education and outreach. Social workers, counselors, funeral directors, church leaders, hospital and hospice staff, human resource personnel and civic leaders rely on our assistance when needed.

Cornerstone of Hope has three Ohio office locations: Independence, Columbus and Lima.
