Traumatic Loss Response Team Coordinator – Central Ohio

Do you desire to add purpose and meaning to your professional career? Do you feel called to work in ministry? Do you possess a missionary heart full of compassion? Cornerstone of Hope is excited to announce this newly created position in the Mid-Ohio Region. The qualified candidate will create and launch a traumatic loss response team comprised of dedicated volunteers who proactively provide support at the scene after a death incident by suicide, overdose or traumatic loss. Dynamic, organized, personable, empathetic and trustworthy are words that describe the ideal candidate to join Cornerstone of Hope, Central Ohio's leading provider of bereavement services.

Traumatic Loss Team Coordinator Job Responsibilities

1. Program Direction – 90%

Serves as the Primary Leader for the Traumatic Loss Response Team (TLRT) Program

- Builds key partnerships with leaders in four Ohio counties: Delaware, Morrow, Marion and Crawford.
- Maintains regular contact with partnering agencies of each county that specialize in prevention and post-vention services and networks with related community members.
- Recruits, hires, develops, maintains and supervises staff and TLRT volunteers to meet the program needs and respond to calls.
- Facilitates marketing and communication strategy to create awareness of the program.
- Relentlessly promotes this new program.

Conducts Appropriate Survivor Follow-up Contact

- Develops a standard follow-up procedure with immediate survivors after the response at the scene in collaboration with Cornerstone of Hope's Clinical Director.
- Recruits, trains and facilitates staff to offer grief support groups in communities.
- Makes referrals to Cornerstone for counseling/groups as appropriate.
- Provides direct care to small caseload of clients through counseling or groups (if clinically qualified).

2. Mission Cultivation – 10%

- Prioritizes strategic initiatives utilizing EOS model.
- Conducts and attends team meetings.
- Promotes the mission of Cornerstone of Hope.
- Assists with traditional Cornerstone of Hope programs: grief camps, memorial services, workshops and retreats.



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Qualifications:

Undergraduate degree in social services, master's degree with independent licensure (PCC-S or LISW-S) and 3 years supervisory/program management preferred. Will consider non-traditional applicants if you feel called to this specific mission and ministry. Must be able to lead a team and build a community program, 40+ hours per week. Trauma informed care, prior supervisory role and ministry start-up experience will have an advantage. Applicants should have experience with bereavement and be comfortable providing individual and group services.

Must be available for occasional travel throughout Delaware, Morrow, Marion and Crawford Counties.

As a non-profit organization, Cornerstone of Hope values faith, compassion, commitment and passion. These core values shape the culture of the entire organization. The value of faith is intentionally listed first of all values. Ephesians 2:20 reads "Built upon the foundation of the apostles and the prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the cornerstone..." Cornerstone of Hope believes that Jesus is the cornerstone of this mission. We welcome and serve all who seek support, just as Christ did. The Traumatic Loss Response Team Coordinator will be responsible for establishing an everyday culture of a Christ-centered ministry.

The successful candidate must:

1. Submit a resume
2. Submit a cover letter
 - a. Cover letter should focus on how you demonstrate Cornerstone of Hope's core values of faith, compassion, commitment and passion
3. Answer these application questions:
 - a. Do you have experience in creating a new program? Explain.
 - b. If you possess an independent clinical license, how many years of practice do you have related to trauma? What type of clinical supervisory experience do you have?
 - c. If you do not possess a clinical background, what experience do you have related to trauma?
4. Provide 2 professional references and 2 personal references.
